Vendors will also be able to setup from 6 a.m. Until 8 a.m. Saturday, October 9th. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE OUT OF THE PARK BY 8 A.M and will not be allowed back in the park until 5 p.m. Saturday. No earlier.

Lafayette County Sheriff's Department will NOT allow the following:

- No Alcohol, No Explosives (i.e. fireworks, poppers), No by-products (i.e. silly string, confetti, etc), No Pets.

Security will be provided on Friday and Saturday during the event. Lafayette County Sheriff Department will have a Rapid Deployment Center located in the park.

Deadline for applications is September 30, 2021.
